


ROAD SAFETY POLICY



The aspiration of Torrent Power Limited - Distribution (TPL-D) is to eliminate any vehicle incident from its business operations, including injuries to staff & stakeholders of company related to road risk. TPL-D strives to ensure safety and security of all its employees and stakeholders working on site as well as travelling outside for business purpose.

TPL-D is committed to:

- > Ensure compliance to all applicable rules and regulations pertaining to occupational road risk.
- > Establish well-defined structure of roles, responsibility, accountability and authorities for employees of process handling department, managing occupational road risk.
- > Manage traffic movement within the premise and at the site to prevent any incident or accident that can result in injury to personnel and damage to equipment, property and vehicles.
- > Coordinate a timely emergency evacuation response in the event of any emergencies within the site related to occupational road risk.
- > Provide properly maintained vehicles, where travelling and or driving are a role requirement and to ensure that vehicle issues reported by user are rectified promptly.
- > Assess the risk relating to the use of vehicles on company business and implement suitable control measures.
- > Continually improve in occupational road safety performance to minimise risk by monitoring & investigating accidents and incidents on regular basis.
- > Ensure that personnel driving for company business are legally entitled to drive with a valid driving license for the relevant class of vehicle.
- > Ensure fitness of drivers by periodic health surveillance.
- > Provide regular training to drivers on safe and defensive driving and vehicle inspection.
- > Periodically evaluate implementation and effectiveness of road safety through Inspections and Audits.
- > Ensure full implementation and sustainability of road safety policy by providing adequate resources and periodical review of the policy.
